## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND SALE OF WORKS MURRAY BRIDGE ROTARY ART SHOW 2021

The Rotary Clubs of Mobilong & Murray Bridge Rotary Art Show Committee hereafter referred to as "The Clubs"

1. Each exhibitor may enter a maximum of three (3) original works in each category – 2D (Painting etc), Photography & 3D (Ceramics/sculpture etc). Where a piece is comprised of more than 1 piece and each piece is offered separately for sale – then each is deemed to be a separate entry. An entry fee of \$15 per work entered is due and payable at time of entry and no later than 24<sup>th</sup> April 2020.
2. Each work must be **SUITABLY FRAMED** and ready to hang/install, including D-rings and/or hanging wire on 2D works & will be the original work of the exhibitor. **Works will be accepted up to a maximum of 1.5m<sup>2</sup>** [Use of alternative materials will result in the work not being hung]. Where an entry is comprised of more than 1 piece the total exhibit must not exceed **1.5m<sup>2</sup>**.
3. The exhibitor is asked to list the entries in the order of priority for hanging so that if in the event of more works being received than hanging space available, the artists preferred works can be selected for hanging. The order and placement within the gallery is at the discretion of The Clubs and the Gallery Director.
4. Each work must have a copy of the "ENTRY TICKET" affixed to the back.
5. IF A WORK IS NOT SELECTED FOR HANGING, THE ENTRY FEE IS NON REFUNDABLE.
6. THE CLUBS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO EXHIBIT SUCH OF THE ENTRIES AS THE CLUBS SELECT for the period the show is open to the public, and The Clubs shall be entitled to offer any entry for sale to the public at the price endorsed on the work and, in the event of a sale being effected, The Clubs shall be entitled to **retain twenty-five per centum of the sale price (exclusive of any GST)** as a selling commission. Artists registered for GST will receive the GST component to be forwarded to the Australian Taxation Office
7. **No work shall be awarded more than one prize.**

8. The judge or judges of the exhibition as appointed by The Clubs will inspect all entries, and their decision shall be final.
9. The Clubs will exercise all reasonable care in handling the entries submitted, but will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to any entries while in the custody of The Clubs or their agents or being sent to or from the Art Show. **ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INSURING THEIR WORKS AGAINST LOSS OR DAMAGE.**
10. Entries must be delivered free of all charges. No payments whatsoever will be made by The Clubs for freight, or other charges incurred in delivery or return.
11. The Clubs may allow any entry to be reproduced in Newspapers, Magazines, the Exhibition Catalogues, Exhibition web site, or by Television or as otherwise used for promotional purposes.
12. ENTRIES WILL BE RECEIVED AT THE **MURRAY BRIDGE REGIONAL GALLERY, SIXTH STREET, MURRAY BRIDGE, FROM 10AM WEDNESDAY 5<sup>th</sup> MAY 2021 & NO LATER THAN 4PM THE SAME DAY. ENTER VIA THE GALLERY.**  
  
IF NOT DELIVERED BY HAND, CONSIGNED SO TO ARRIVE AT THE MURRAY BRIDGE REGIONAL GALLERY, SIXTH STREET, MURRAY BRIDGE, BEFORE 4-00 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY 5<sup>th</sup> MAY 2021.
13. ENTRIES MUST BE COLLECTED FROM THE REGIONAL GALLERY, MURRAY BRIDGE, FROM 9.00AM. TO 1PM TUESDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2021.
14. All works must be for sale.
15. Exhibitors whose work bears a "red sticker" should check at the sales desk that the work has been sold. No responsibility can be accepted in respect of red stickers affixed in error.

17. In the event of a dispute arising regarding the interpretation of these conditions, the decision of The Clubs of shall be final and binding on all parties.
